A review of high-level business processes for IAM and the relation of licensing to corporate strategy. Learn to guide and manage components of the high level process to create deal opportunities, create sustainable deal flow and to manage your IP cost-effectively over time.

The Deal

Identify and apply valuation approaches. Recognize and practise elements of successful negotiation. Includes an extensive licence negotiation exercise based on case study materials from earlier sessions.

Living with the Deal

Understand what happens after the deal is made. Construct a strategy for IP management. Know the tools for managing IP and licensing agreements. Understand how business processes affect IAM.
